Reporting to the CHPP Manager, The CHPP Superintendent is responsible for managing maintenance activities and to provide operational support to the CHPP Manager. This includes the safe, efficient and cost effective operation, ensuring planning and scheduling of all maintenance work, troubleshooting equipment availability and reliability problems, and ensuring that production targets are not adversely affected by insufficient maintenance. This will also involve effectively managing all maintenance staff including contractors when required. In the absence of the Manager the role will assume the responsibility for coordinating production activities and leading the Operations team to safely deliver the annual coal production plan by optimising activities and continually improving the performance of the CHPP.

- Coordinating production activities, effective planning and scheduling as well as effectively managing all maintenance staff including contractors when required.
- Manage the performance of all CHPP activities, deliver against agreed targets and schedules.
- Ensuring both permanent and contract employees work safety and efficiently whilst carrying out their duties with due regard for quality of work.
- Enforcement of mine standards.
- Providing accurate reports on both safety and operational performance.
- Clearly define and communicate performance goals and provide regular and objective feedback on performance.
- Providing leadership to development teams including coaching, support and training on sequence control processes.
- Developing and implementing key standards and audit checklists to safely achieve production targets.
